**A.** "A man puts on a ridiculous hat before going into a business meeting. What might his goals be for that meeting?"

**B.** "What might a 38-year old-actuary with a family hope to accomplish by confronting Maxima Tiger in single combat?"

**EXPLAIN WHY SOMEONE MIGHT DO SOMETHING THAT GOES AGAINST ONE OF THEIR GOALS.**

SUGGESTED PROMPTS

**A.** "A man wants to live a good, honest life; right now, he is robbing a bank. What is he hoping to accomplish?"

**B.** "An animal rights activist is in a desert. She sees a turtle on its back, baking in the hot sun. But she's not helping. Why isn't she helping?"

**PRIMARY**

SUSPECT MUST RLI

**EXPLAIN WHAT MIGHT MOTIVATE SOMEONE TO GO AGAINST EXPECTATIONS.**

3/6 TO BE HUMAN

SUGGESTED PROMPTS

**A.** "A renowned public speaker walks out on stage, but instead of giving his prepared speech, he begins screaming obscenities. What does he hope to accomplish by doing this?"

**B.** "A man is pumping water from a well, despite knowing that the well is poisoned. What does he hope to accomplish?"

**A.** "While acting, this person hums the national anthem of a country other than the one he is in. How does that change what you believe they intend?"

**B.** "While acting, this person is openly weeping. How does this change what you see as their intentions?"
